2. Find three ways your community collects data about itself. Who owns that data? Write a short paragraph explaining why this matters.
3. Compare the Va'a/Waka (Pacific canoe) to the Yvy Marā Eÿ (Guaraní Land Without Evil). Both are about journeys. How are they similar? How are they different?
4. Post the Koru meme on social media:

5. Write a one-sentence definition of data in your own language.

Activities / Ngā Mahi / Atividades

1. Research one example of a company training AI on Indigenous content without consent. Write a 200-word analysis using the Niho Taniwha (colonial bite) framework.
2. The Luta pela Vida meme (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_luta_pela_vida.png) was inspired by APIB's 2021 Brasília camp. Research APIB and write 3 facts.
3. Draw the Kayapó jaguar body paint pattern. What does dividing the body into zones mean symbolically? How could this apply to data sovereignty?
4. Write a tweet (280 chars) in the style of Mangōpare (hammerhead shark courage): firm, determined, fighting back. Use #DataColonialism.
5. Map the data companies that operate in your region. Who profits from your community's data?

Atividades (Português)

3. Desenhe o padrão de pintura corporal jaguar Kayapó. O que significa dividir o corpo em zonas simbolicamente? Como isso se aplica à soberania de dados?
4. Escreva um tweet (280 chars) no estilo do Mangōpare (coragem do tubarão-martelo): firme, determinado, resistente. Use #ColonialismodeDados.
5. Mapeie as empresas de dados que operam na sua região. Quem lucra com os dados da sua comunidade?

1. The CARE Principles are: Collective Benefit, Authority to Control, Responsibility, Ethics. Apply each to the Guna Mola textile tradition (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_mola_guna.png). Write one sentence per principle.
2. Design a 'data governance policy' for your school or community based on tikanga or your own cultural values. Use the Kōwhaiwhai rafter as inspiration — the law written on the ceiling.
3. The Malu diamond protects Samoan women. Research what 'protection' means in digital contexts. Write 3 recommendations for protecting Indigenous data.
4. Create a meme using the Manaia (spiritual guardian) concept. Message: 'Who guards your data in the digital world?' Post it with #CAREPrinciples.
5. Compare CARE Principles to GDPR (EU) and the Privacy Act (NZ). What does each protect? What does each miss?

1. The Takarangi double spiral encodes past and future simultaneously. Draw a timeline of your community's land history. Where does data colonialism intersect?
2. Research the Ñandutí spider-web lace of Paraguay (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_nanduti.png). How does the web structure relate to digital network topologies?
3. The Fijian Masi Kesa identifies clan membership. Design a 'cultural data passport' – what information should it contain and who should control it?
4. Vonu (sea turtle) represents navigation and endurance (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_vonu.png). Write a navigation metaphor for how Indigenous communities should move through the internet.
5. The Manulua (two birds, Tongan) represents alliance. Research two Indigenous communities that have formed a data sovereignty alliance. Describe the partnership.

3. The Cuaracy Ra'Angaba (Guaraní solar calendar) tracks seasons and ceremonies (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_cuaracy_ra_angaba.png). Design a 'data calendar' – when should communities review who accesses their data?

2. Research Te Hiku Media's Māori voice recognition project. Write 3 lessons other Indigenous communities could apply to AI development.
3. The Jagua Pytã (Guaraní cosmic jaguar) holds multiple realities simultaneously (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_jagua_pyta.png). Write a manifesto for an Indigenous AI future in your own language.
4. The Pe'a (Samoaan male tattoo / sacred rite of passage) encodes genealogy in skin (https://pub-bf8eea881c1e44d88eda5192c3b92291.r2.dev/motifs/memes/meme_pea.png). How could biometric AI (face recognition, voice ID) threaten or honour this tradition?
